Request to form a litter picking group

The Council has received the following request from a member of the Space4_Crewkerne group:

"I have some local residents who have expressed an interest in helping to form litter picking groups, who could meet several times a year to pick litter from areas around the town. I was involved in a similar scheme in a local village and it proved very effective. I am not sure if something already exists in town, but certainly on the larger estates I have not seen any evidence of this.

I feel not only would it help give people a sense of pride in the town, but also might help deter some of the dog fouling as paths would be cleaner, so people might just be more considerate, and it would certainly tie in well with the aims of Space 4 Crewkerne if we made some of public footpaths closer to the town centre moving out to the estates tidier and more pleasant to use. I feel it would be more likely to succeed if we worked with the Town Council as there would need to be designated place to leave the collected litter and some small expense would be required for the equipment.

I realise we cannot entertain this scheme under current regulations, but I am hopeful that by early Spring we could start off in a small way and see if the idea grows.

I have attached two photos of the things which might be needed [litter pickers and gloves] and wondered if you could please ask if this might be considered on the first possible Agenda so Councillors can consider the idea and let us know if they would be happy to help coordinate the effort and purchase some of the equipment."
