



# Young Crewkernian Award 2026

## DO YOU KNOW A SPECIAL YOUNG PERSON?

The 'Young Crewkernian Award' recognises and celebrates children and young people who have done something outstanding, made a difference in their school or community, or have overcome challenges. Children and young people up to and including Year 11, attending a Crewkerne school or living in Crewkerne can be recognised by parents, carers, community members, other pupils, friends, and school staff for going above and beyond. Nominations are now open and will close on Monday 9 March 2026.

A Young Crewkernian could be a child or young person who:

- helps out in the community
- cares for the environment
- has learned a special skill
- or something else worthy of recognition

If you're under 16, you'll need a parent, carer or other responsible adult to email your nomination. They will need to send your nomination via their own email address and state their name and job role. For example, teacher, parent, volunteer. Submissions will be reviewed and used to select winners of a Young Crewkernian Award.

Certificates will be shared with the child or young person's school or directly to the parent, carer or other responsible adult's email address for community nominations.

# INFORMATION PROCESSING NOTICE

This notice is about Crewkerne Town Council and the collection of personal information for the Honoured Citizen Award.

Crewkerne Town Council will be referred to as 'we', 'us' or 'our' in this notice. We are the data controller for the information you provide, this means we decide how your personal data is processed and for what purposes in relation to this initiative .

- your organisation (if applicable) including the type and name
- the name, age and contact details of the young person you're nominating
- the nominees address and school if applicable
- a description of what you're nominating the young person for

We'll keep the completed nominations for 2 years after submission.

We'll process your data as a legitimate interest for the purpose of recording your nomination, the sending out of a certificate, and the celebration of achievement.
